Plugin Overview

Visualise User Progress based on the estimates entered by them. Set up this gadget to view and track completed and remaining work of your team members.

So easy to use and a must have gadget for any team.

The **JIRA Ultimate Estimations Gadget** plugin includes the following functionality:

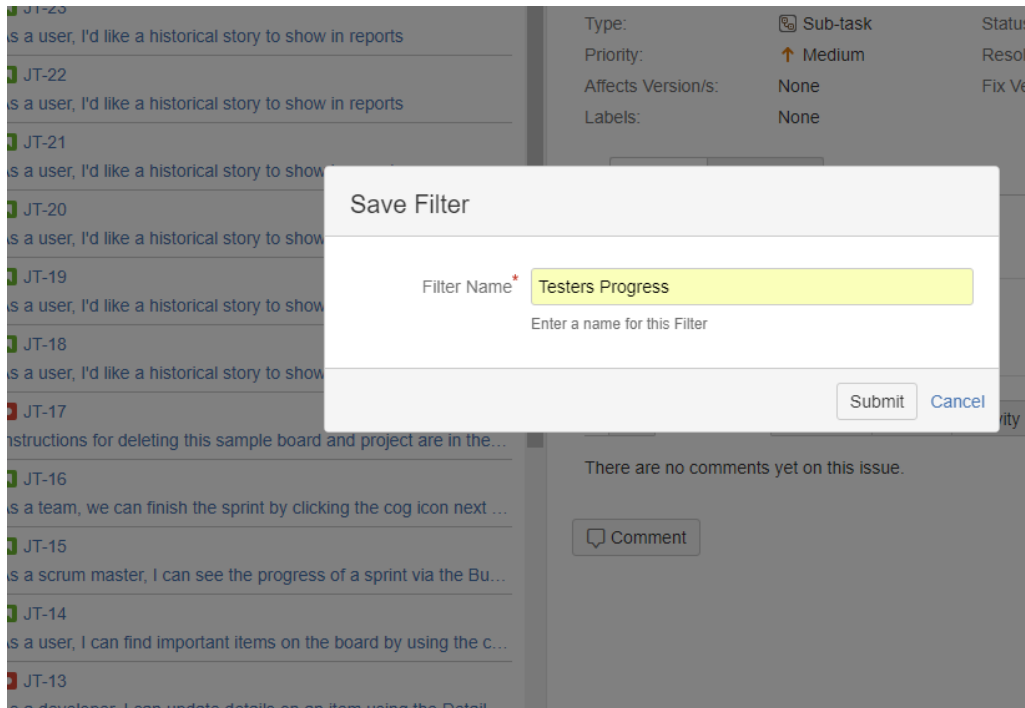
- Track User Progress based on the overall time estimates from the configured filter.
- Works with issues returned by simple to create and set up filters
- Color schemes to differentiate the amount of work Completed & Remaining along with Under Estimations.
- Works best with [Jira Ultimate Role Tracking & Estimation](#) plugin, by showing the progress based on Role Assignees and Estimates.

The following documentation will outline how to add and configure JIRA Ultimate Estimations Gadget.

Configuration

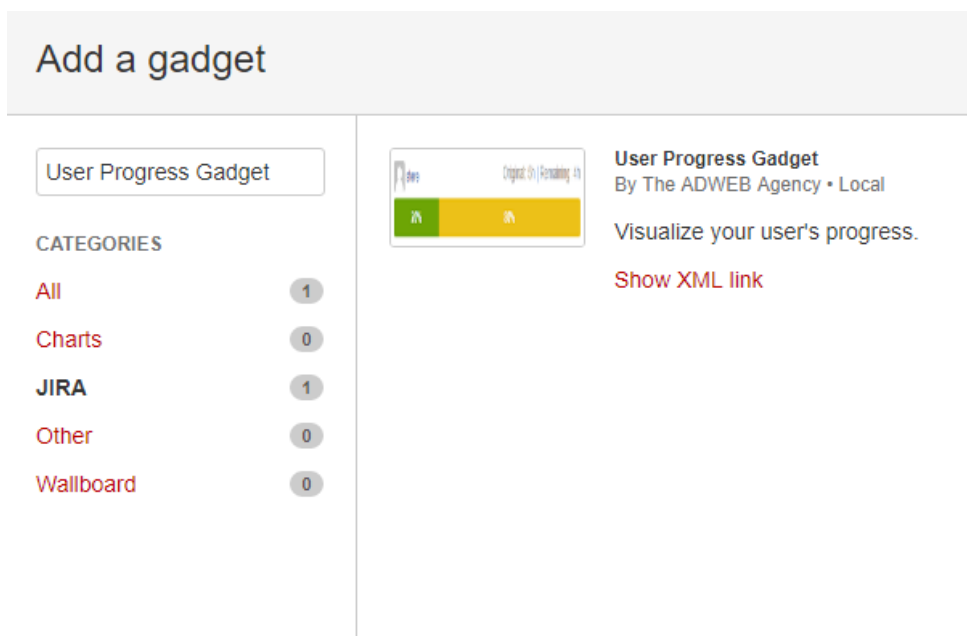
Step 1 :

Create a filter for as per your need from the search page or use an existing one. You will need this filter for gadget configuration.




Step 2 :

Add the gadget on the dashboard from “Add Gadget” option on the dashboard configuration. You can find the gadget with the name “User Progress Gadget” under “JIRA” category.



Step 3 :

Use the filter created in the 1st step and configure the gadget. Note that the progress shown in the gadget will be based on each user assigned and the estimates entered in the issues returned by the filter.
